The archives is a place of knowledge, memory, nourishment, and power. Archives at once protect and preserve records; legitimize and sanctify certain documents while negating and destroying others; and provide access to selected sources while controlling the researchers and conditions under which they may examine the archival record.

This paper argues that archives play a significant role in fostering three elements essential to Cambodia's recovery: accountability, truth, and memory.
