This case concerns a complaint brought by the Federal Trade Commission ("FTC" or "Commission") against petitioner Thompson Medical Company under Secs. 5 and 12 of the FTC Act. 15 U.S.C. §§ 45 & 52. **North Carolina State Board of Dental Examiners v. FTC ...**

In our opinion the Commission has confused "injury to competition" with the normal effect resulting from the differences which normally arise in the buying of smaller or larger quantities of any product, which we held did not constitute wrongful discrimination (Corn Products Refining Co. v. Federal Trade Commission, supra, 144 F.2d 220).

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
