New York Medicaid Eligibility Requirements

Eligibility for New York Medicaid is something that is determined by a few different factors that have been developed by the New York state department. The benefits given by Medicaid will aid those who are unable to pay their medical bills, such as those on SSI (Supplemental Security Income) and others who meet the requirements for eligibility.

You can find more detailed information about state-specific Medicaid eligibility requirements on Medicaid.gov. A single Medicaid applicant may keep up to \$2,000 in countable assets and still qualify. Generally, the government considers certain assets to be exempt or "non-countable" (usually up to a specific allowable amount).

Assets You Can Have and Still Qualify for Medicaid ...

Medicaid beneficiaries generally must be residents of the state in which they are receiving Medicaid. They must be either citizens of the United States or certain qualified non-citizens, such as lawful permanent residents. In addition, some eligibility groups are limited by age, or by pregnancy or parenting status.

Eligibility | Medicaid

Financial eligibility is determined based on the income and resource standards governing the Public Health Insurance Programs. Persons eligible for Medicaid may be required to enroll in a Managed Care plan. Applications - Eligibility Information

Who is eligible for New York Medicaid? In order to qualify for this benefit program, you must be a resident of the state of New York, in need of health care/insurance assistance, and whose financial situation would be characterized as low income or very low income.

In order to qualify into the Medicaid Buy-In Program, you must be a New York state resident, be at least 16 years old, have a gross income of \$60,420 to \$81,132, be employed on a part-time or full-time basis and have a Social Security Administration-defined disability. In New York, your are eligible for Medicaid if you have no more than \$13,800 in resources (assets), and no more than \$20,100 for married couples. To be eligible for community-based programs, you are allowed no more than \$787 in monthly income, although an Elder Law attorney can advise you on effective strategies to protect your "surplus" income.

New York Medicaid Eligibility Requirements For Seniors ...

Income requirements: Families with children can qualify for Medicaid with household incomes up to 165% of the FPL (\$26,796 a year for a family of two). Families with infants or pregnant mothers can qualify with incomes up to 200% of the FPL (\$32,480 for a family of two.)

A state-by-state guide to Medicaid: Do I qualify ...

Children from age one to eighteen are eligible for Medicaid with a household income up to 149 percent of poverty, but the state also has separate CHIP (Children's Health Insurance Program) coverage available for children with household incomes up to 400 percent of poverty level - the highest threshold in the country.

Medicaid provides free health insurance for low-income adults and children. It may also provide up to 90 days of retroactive coverage for unpaid medical bills, if you request this coverage and are eligible during those 90 days.
