You must report other untimed codes (for example, "add- on" codes) based on the number of times the health care professional performed the procedure (for example, bill an add-on HCPCS debridement code, in addition to its "base" code, for each additional 20 square centimeters of tissue removed).

All Therapy Services (PT,OT,SP) 7 Plans of Care -Services must relate directly and specifically to a written treatment plan. -Must be established by: •Therapist who will provide the services (PT,OT, SP) •Physician/NPP -Must be •Signed •Dated •And have the professional's identification (e.g. MD, PT, OT)

Medicare Rules for Documentation Medicare reimburses for Part B physical and occupational therapy services when the claim form and supporting documentation accurately report medically necessary covered services. Thus, developing legible and relevant documentation is only one piece of the reimbursement puzzle. Your documentation must also:

Medicare Part B Documentation Requirements For Physical ...

Documentation should clearly indicate the rationale for co-treatment and state the goals that will be addressed through this method of intervention. Co-treatment sessions should be documented as such by each practitioner, stating which goals were addressed and the progress made.

Documentation in Occupational Therapy: Guidelines ...

No greater than 1-2 services/units of this code should be used on each visit date. If this code is used in conjunction with CPT 97110 or CPT 97530 on any given visit date, only 1-2 services/units of CPT 97112 are generally covered. Documentation must support the number of services/units for each visit date. Additional Documentation Requirements

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
