Locate the service valve inside your Freon kit. It will be the large connector valve found amongst the kit's other contents. Plug the service valve into a compressor line (one of the lines you located next to the compressor earlier) in air conditioner unit.

To attach the recharge hose, place the quick-connect fitting — found on the end of the recharge hose — over the port and push down firmly until you hear it click into place. Be careful not to pull the trigger at this time as this will release refrigerant from the AC system into the atmosphere.

Find the low pressure line port, which will have thicker tubing. There are two ports on your air conditioner. You will add the refrigerant to the low pressure line port, not the high pressure line port. The low pressure line has larger tubing than the high pressure line, making it easy to distinguish between the 2.

Open the valve on the recharge hose which will add refrigerant to the system. Adding a Bullet Valve Schrader Valve A bullet valve is a quick and easy way to add a recharging port to an A/C unit. Window air conditioners do not usually have a service port which is easily fixed with a low-cost bullet valve.

For most vehicles, the low pressure side fill port is located on the left side of the engine bay. It will often be a small section of metal pipe that has two lengths of rubber hose coming off either end. Look to the back of the engine bay called the firewall.

An "evac and recharge" service consists of connecting your car's AC system to a special machine, which vacuums all the old refrigerant and oil from the system, and then refills it to the proper level.
